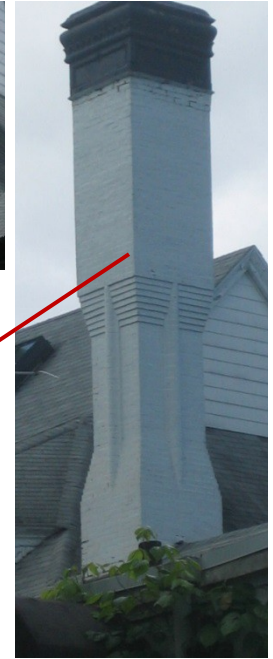
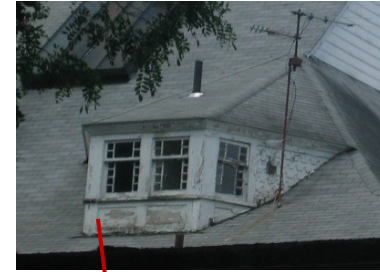
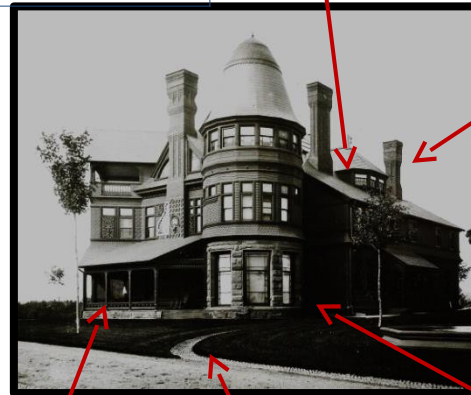


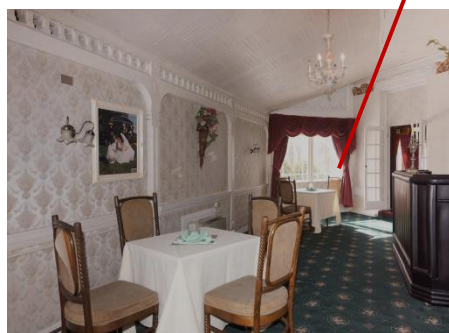


Remaining Exterior Architecture
